The Yobuko Morning Market is one of the three biggest morning markets of Japan and is open to visitors every day of the year aside from New Year's Day. At the food stands, you can find everything from the seafood catch of the day to freshly picked fruits and vegetables. As many as 50 stands can be found on weekdays and Saturdays, with up to 70 stands on Sundays and national holidays. Customers can also package and ship the items they buy here to their destination of choice.

Nagoya Castle comes to life in CG!



Nagoya Castle Ruins Special Historic Site Saga Prefectural Nagoya Castle Museum

Slightly smaller in size compared to Osaka Castle, Nagoya Castle was erected as the base from which Japan's second "great unifier" Toyotomi Hideyoshi launched his invasions of the Korean peninsula. While only ruins of the castle remain today, VR technology is allowing users to experience the castle as it once was. The popular "VR Nagoya Castle" experience lets users point tablet devices toward the surrounding ruins to bring up a digital representation of its intact state. Visitors to the museum can learn about the history of the castle all the while perusing the main diorama on display.

A designated National Natural Monument, the Nanatsugama Caves were shaped by the rough waters of the Genkai Sea into the captivating form they take today. Sightseers can climb aboard the squid-shaped excursion boat "Ikamaru" to get a close-up view of the caves for themselves.

Genkai

Founded in 1969, this shop originated the concept of "ikizukuri" for squid, a style of food arrangement in which a squid is sliced and presented in a dish as if in its original form. At Genkai, visitors can enjoy squid ikizukuri year-round. The squids are selected from a tank inside the restaurant and then sliced and served in just one minute's time, allowing customers to taste the freshest squid possible.
